Any Beauty Therapist with:

- NZARBP membership
- A minimum of 18 months and a maximum of three years of experience
- No serious complaints received about their work to date

How do I enter this category?

Entry Questions:

1. Tell us about yourself (15 points)

(1000 words maximum)

Describe yourself as a therapist (Maximum 1000 words). Include the following:

- Describe your relevant experience, background and qualifications
- Provide details of your skill set
- Detail your area of expertise
- Tell us your reasons for working in the industry

2. What are people saying about your clinic, and what have you achieved? (5 points)

- Please provide client/supplier endorsements and their contact details for verification
- Provide details of any awards previously won, including a copy of the certificate

3. Case Studies (25 points per case study)

Provide **three** case studies demonstrating your area of expertise. These should include before and after photos, and a full explanation of how you came to the end result. *Ensure you include a thorough consultation, a full description of the treatment plan including home care plans, and client testimonials.*

What happens next?

Entries must be received by **06 May 2019**. Any entries received after this date will not be accepted.

If you are a Finalist, you will receive notification via email by **03 June 2019**

All Finalists will receive a clinic visit.

Finalist interviews will be conducted face-to-face or via video conferencing, with **dates to be confirmed**.

All Finalists are expected to attend the Awards ceremony on **Saturday 14 September 2019** at the **Hilton Hotel, Auckland**. This is a formal event, and winners will be announced on the night.
