Any Cosmetic Tattooist with:

- NZARBP membership
- At least two years of experience
- No serious complaints received about their work to date.
- Current First Aid certificate

How do I enter this category?

- 6. Finalists will be announced 03 November 2023

Questions:

1. Tell us about yourself (15 points)

Describe yourself as a Cosmetic Tattooist. Include the following: (1000 words maximum)

- Describe your relevant experience, background and qualifications
- Provide details of your skill set
- Detail your area of expertise
- Explain how you comply with NZARBP, Local Government and Central Government bylaws and regulations regarding health, hygiene and safety practices and infection control measures.
- Tell us your reasons for working in the industry

2. What are people saying about you and what have you achieved? (5 points)

- Please provide client/supplier endorsements and their contact details for verification
- Provide details of any awards previously won, including a copy of the certificate

3. Portfolio (50 points)

Provide a full portfolio, demonstrating different applications, techniques and styles. The portfolio must also contain at least 3 photos of healed results.

4. Video presentation (30 points)

• Provide us with a video of yourself – video must include service set up, infection control procedures and 2 minutes of a service

What happens next?

Entries must be received by **06 October 2023** Any entries received after this date will not be accepted.

If you are a Finalist, you will receive notification via email by 03 November 2023

Finalist interviews will be conducted via video conferencing, with dates to be confirmed.

All Finalists are expected to attend the Awards ceremony on **24 February 2024 at Tote on Ascot, Ellerslie Racecourse, Auckland**. This is a formal event, and winners will be announced on the night.
